 It is unlawful to practice as a Registered Nurse in South Dakota without holding a valid Temporary Pern current license to practice as a Registered Nurse. An individual holding a RN Temporary Permit shall only practice under the supervision of Registered Nu duty in the area where the holder of the permit is practicing. Temporary permits become invalid upon the notification of the results of the first examination or ninet following the date of issuance. Temporary Permits are not renewable. Temporary permits are Single-State (Valid only in South Dakota). If I change employers I must notify the Board of Nursing so a new permit can be issued and that I will be charged \$25 for each additional permit. I further understand that in cases of violation of the law, penalties may be imposed. I also understand that I am to use the initial R.N. App (Registered Nurse Applicant). 	urse on ty day
