



A total of **1,331** open seats were available; **939** applicants were offered placement; **842** were accepted and enrolled; and **489 (36.7%)** seats were left vacant.



752 RN graduates were produced by South Dakota's nursing programs69% were residents of South Dakota76% licensed as an RN in South Dakota


